Annual Meeting

The SAIL 2017 conference was held May 16-19 at the University of Wisconsin-Madison, Wisconsin Water Library, hosted by Anne Moser (UW-Madison) and Alisun DeKock (Shedd Aquarium). Jaime Goldman, Kay Garsnett, Kristen LaBonte and Eleanor Uhlinger assisted with the planning and programming for this conference.

The conference theme was “*Great Lakes, Great Libraries*” and included presentations by both SAIL and Cyamus members, vendors from ProQuest and Springer Nature, as well as UW-Press. Featured guest speakers included **David Hart**, senior scientist with the Wisconsin Aquatic Sciences Center and assistant director for extension at the UW-Sea Grant Institute; **Jake Walsh**, postdoctoral researcher at the UW-Madison Center for Limnology; **Garrett Johnson**, stewardship specialist for the Great Lakes department at the John G. Shedd Aquarium in Chicago, IL; and **Sarah FitzSimons**, a visual artist and assistant professor of sculpture at UW-Madison whose projects often involve oceans and rivers, like her recent work entitled *Water Books*.

There were several field trips including a tour of the State Capitol Building and a tour and luncheon at the Aldo Leopold Center in Monona.
