Annual Meeting

The SAIL 2018 conference was held April 17-20 at the Smithsonian Environmental Research Center (SERC) in Edgewater, Maryland and was hosted by Susan Zwicker. Michelle Leonard, University of Florida, Marston Science Library and Angela Clark-Hughes, University of Miami's Rosenstiel School of Marine and Atmospheric Library assisted with the planning and programming for this conference.

The conference theme was *“Rising Tides in Research and Preservation”* and included presentations from members of SAIL and Smithsonian Libraries, as well as Kristen Culp from ProQuest.

Featured guest speakers included **Nancy Knowlton**, Sant Chair for Marine Science, Smithsonian National Museum of Natural History; **Katie Wagner**, Book Conservator, Smithsonian Libraries; and **Bill Ball**, Director of the Chesapeake Research Consortium.

There were several field trips including a tour of SERC's LEED Platinum Mathias Laboratory, and a trip to Washington, DC for tours of Dibner and Cullman, Smithsonian's rare book libraries.
