The 2016 meeting was held March 2-5 at Cal Poly State University, San Luis Obispo, California and hosted by Jeanine Scaramozzino. The conference, "Bringing It All Back Home: Reprints to Networked Data," included a number of presentations by Cal Poly faculty and staff as well as Cyamus members.
