Annual Report of AFRIAMSLIC-2019

MEMBERSHIPS STATUS

There are **31** members from **20** countries in Africa:

- New Members (6):
 - **4** sponsored by IAMSLIC for 3-year 2019-2021(1from Cameroon, 3 from Uganda)
 - 1 from Cameroon
 - **1** from Uganda (sponsored by Ian Stewart for 3-year 2019-2021).
- Renewed Memberships (20):
 - **13** sponsored by IODE/IOC for 2 years: 2018-2019
 - 7 sponsored by ASFA/FAO for the 3-year period 2019-2021
- <u>Potential Members</u>: a preliminary list of potential members from different countries in Africa was developed and special efforts were made to recruit new members from Egypt and Sudan (ASFA will fund).

ACTIVITIES

2019 was a quite busy and challenging year for AFRIAMSLIC.

Restructuring of AFRIAMSLIC:

An effort to restructure AFRIAMSLIC was a priority in order to involve in its activities the maximum members, to strengthen communication among them, to provide new opportunities for creating equitable and more lasting outcomes.

In order to involve its members in activities maximally, AFRIAMSLIC carried out restructuring to strengthen communication and providing new opportunities for creating equitable and more lasting outcomes.

The creating of Executive Board, Committees and Sub-Committees was very vital for the good functioning of the regional association. Much of AFRIAMSLIC's work was done on a volunteer basis by the members of board and committees. Boards and committees carry out a variety of tasks.

Afriamslic Executive Board: It was important to create a team involving committees' representatives who were willing to carry out projects and activities. The Board organizes monthly virtual meetings through Skype on the 1st Tuesday of the being of each month. These meetings are an opportunity to follow up progress made in the activities, to move ongoing projects forward in order to achieve visible and concrete results in a short time. The AFRIAMSLIC Executive Board is comprised actually of eight members:

- <u>Committees, Sub-Committees, Leaders and Sub-Regional Representatives</u>: Five committees were set upon April 2019. Inside Committees, there are leaders, sub-committees, sub-regional representatives and staff.

• **Membership Committee** (Mercy Stephen Sebuliba, Leader): This committee shall be responsible for increasing members of AFRIAMSLIC by attracting new members and encouraging renewal of memberships (of all librarians, active and retired; library graduate students, friends...), updating the list of members, plan activities for members to be involved in.

- Sub-Regional Committees and Representatives: Acting within a decentralized approach, AFRIAMSLIC created in September 2019, 5 sub-committees under Membership Committee and designate Regional Representatives. They shall be responsible for recruiting new members from their sub-regions, identifying other potential member organizations and updating the list of members in their sub regions of Africa:
 - North Africa Representative: Bouchra Bazi (Morocco)
 - South Africa Representative: Linea Lipinge (Namibia)
 - West Africa Representative: Coffi Ferdinando Rock GBEDO (Benin)
 - East Africa Representative: Raphael Okeyo (Kenya)
 - Central Africa Representative: Jean Marie Bope (Congo)

• **Marketing & Communication Committee** (Maymouna Kane, Leader): This committee shall be responsible for managing marketing and branding of AFRIAMSLIC, Disseminating the organization information to stakeholders through use of the website, leaflets, flyers, brochures, newsletters and manage social media platforms;

• **Handbook & Bylaws Committee** (Geoffrey Salanje, Leader): This Committee was created to collect all available information about AFRIAMSLIC Association's history, benefits, organization...etc to be put in one book. The primary responsibility of the Handbook and Bylaws Committee is to keep the AFRIAMSLIC Handbook and bylaws updated on a continual basis and a new version is made accessible via the AFRIAMSLIC website. Older versions should be retained for historical purposes.

• **Finance Committee** (Assane Fall, Leader): It shall be responsible for sourcing resources and financial support (as sponsors and partners) to fundraising the association activities and help members to attend meetings and conferences ;

o **Directory Committee** (Raphael Okeyo, Leader): It will be responsible for coordinating with regional and national representatives to collect information to develop and update a database of the **AFRIAMSLIC directory** "Directory of African Aquatic and Marine

Sciences Libraries and Information Centers". Centers involved with aquatic science: Marine, Brackish & Freshwater science ;

* Marketing, Communication & Promotion of AFRIAMSLIC :

Giving a brand name to AFRIAMSLIC: the regional group of Africa shall have a brand name. In June 2019 the executive board has officially approved to maintain the acronym "AFRIAMSLIC" and to name as the "African Association of Aquatic and Marine Science Libraries and Information Centers".

- AFRIAMSLIC Handbook: a draft version of an AFRIAMSLIC Handbook was created to give more information about the regional association and to assist those on the AFRIAMSLIC Executive Board and Committees with managing the organization. The last version will be accessible via the AFRIAMSLIC website.

***** AFRIAMSLIC Meetings and IAMSLIC conference:

AFRIAMSLIC Meetings: There was no regional conference for this year because of funding. However, in addition to monthly meetings (Skype) of the AFRIAMSLIC Board, the regional group had a mini-meeting on 26 September 2019 with 6 AFRIAMSLIC members when attending ASFA Advisory Board Meeting in Terengganu, Malaysia. - IAMSLIC Conference: AFRIAMSLIC has two members attending the upcoming IAMSLIC conference in Texas, USA, 20-25 October 2019 [Leonel Arao (Mozambique) and Eva Mutongole Wamala (Uganda)]. I mention that there was a travel grant application funded partially by IAMSLIC for 1 AFRIAMSLIC member. We thank IAMSLIC for its support.  <u>AFRIAMSLIC Directory Project</u>: AFRIAMSLIC is in the process of carrying out a survey with the aim of coming up with a Directory of Africa Aquatic Institutions, Libraries and Professionals: Involved with aquatic science (Marine, Brackish & Freshwater science).
